As a result of the bathing beach water quality sampling program done through the Van Buren County Environmental Health Division, bathing beaches are monitored for levels of bacteria. Results of samples taken on 08/18/2025 from the bathing beach area at Woolfe Park Beach located on Pine St revealed the surface water quality at the beach area met Michigan's Water Quality Standards for total and/or partial body contact for recreational purposes. The specific test results are:

South end of beach	36.4 /100ml
Middle of beach	30.5 /100ml
North end of beach	36.4 /100ml
Daily mean for 08/18/2025	34.31 /100ml
